## **GRADE 1 PARENTS: FIRST COMMUNION RECEPTION**

Grade One parents are reminded to bring in the items for the First Communion Reception on **Friday, May 5<sup>th</sup>** from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. or on **Saturday, May 6<sup>th</sup>** during set up. Please bring all items to the kitchen in the gym and ensure the fruit is uncut. Label all platters that need to be returned.

## **FIRST COMMUNION-SUNDAY, MAY 7<sup>th</sup>:**

The First Communicants are to be dropped off at the school dressed in their gowns no later than 1:15 p.m. In the case of a downpour, students are to be dropped off in the church meeting room. The group photo will follow and latecomers cannot be accommodated. Parents are to proceed to the church upon arrival. Mass will begin at 2:00 p.m. Please remember that space in the church is limited.

## **FIRST COMMUNION ALTAR SERVERS & MASS CHOIR**

All students who are singing at First Communion are asked to **arrive at 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, May 7<sup>th</sup>**. The First Communion **Choir needs to come in full school uniform**. Altar servers are asked to wear their Sunday best (meet in the sacristy at 1:45 p.m.)

## **SECOND COMMUNION/GRADE TWO CLASS MASS:**

Second Communion is scheduled for **Sunday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at the 11 a.m.** Mass. Upon arriving, First Communicants are to proceed to the front two rows on the right hand side of the church. Students are to wear the communion outfits. Other Grade Two students are to wear their school uniforms and are to sit with their families.

## **CENTENNIAL THEATRE CHORAL CONCERT:**
