MEET THE TEACHERS/CURRICULUM OVERVIEW NIGHT: Thursday, September 14th:

On Thursday, September 14th all parents are invited to come and meet the teachers/staff and PEC members and hear about the curriculum and goals for the school year. There will be a meeting in the gym for all parents (Kindergarten – Grade 7) from 7:00-7:25 p.m. which will be followed by two information sessions (7:30-7:55 p.m. and 8:00-8:25 p.m.) in the various classrooms. This is an important opportunity for you to learn how to support your children in their learning, as you hear about teacher expectations and class curriculum. The information sessions are for parents of children in Grades 1 to 7 only as the Kindergarten information session was already shared at the Kindergarten Spring Meeting.

SCHOOL SCHEDULE/HOURS OF INSTRUCTION:

Regular attendance and prompt arrival at school is important if your child is to gain full benefit from the school program. If your child is going to be late or away for any reason, please call the school office at (604) 929-0345 before 8:45 a.m. to confirm his/her absence or tardiness. If we do not hear from you, we will call home to ensure your child's safety. A written note explaining your child's absence is required when your child returns to school. **Please make sure that arriving to school on time is a priority from the very first day!**

ST. PIUS X SCHOOL UNIFORM:

All students at St. Pius X School are required to have their full uniform at all times. All uniform items are to be purchased through our uniform supplier, Cambridge & Company. All school items, especially uniforms, **MUST** be clearly **marked with your child's FULL NAME** as many students share the same first name, or initials. If you are purchasing new school shoes for children who require orthotics, please ensure the orthotics fit regulation school shoes. (Please refer to the "School Uniform Policy" in the Parent Handbook).

COMMUNICATION: WEEKLY BULLETIN

In order to assist with the communication between home and school, a weekly bulletin will be published every Thursday. It is important that you read the bulletin in order to be informed about school policies and procedures as well as notable accomplishments and upcoming events. In an effort to be environmentally friendly and reduce the amount of paper distributed, the bulletin will be available on our school website: www.saintpius.ca and it will be emailed to you. Please subscribe on our school website to receive your copy. There will also be a few paper copies available at the school office for those families who wish to pick up a paper copy.

PINK NOTICES:

A notice sent home on **PINK PAPER requires your IMMEDIATE ATTENTION**. Please read and sign these notices, as they must be returned by a **DUE DATE**, which is usually the following day. Some pink notices will come home with the eldest child in the family and may require a family payment. In this case, please fill out the individual form and send it back to the eldest child's teacher with the family payment by the due date.

VISITORS IN THE SCHOOL:

Parents, guardians and volunteers are welcome at our school. However, in the interest of child safety and the promotion of student learning, **ALL VISITORS, including parents, grandparents, guardians and volunteers must report to the office first and sign in**. Our staff will provide approved visitors with the appropriate St. Pius X identification badge. **If dropping off an item for your child or for a staff member, please leave it with the office staff**. At the next class break, the item will be given to the child or teacher. We do not support the interruption of classes and the learning process, except in the case of an emergency. The

above procedures will help us to maintain a safe and productive environment for our students. We thank you for your cooperation.

MEDICAL ALERTS:

Ensuring a safe and healthy school environment is a responsibility shared by students, parents and staff. It is important that all members of the school community are aware of their role in promoting children's safety. Please notify the school if your child has any of the following: **A MEDICALLY DIAGNOSED health condition which may require emergency care at school, such as: anaphylaxis, diabetes, severe asthma, seizure disorder, blood clotting disorders or serious heart conditions.** (Please contact the school office to complete a Medical Alert Information Sheet). Please Note: Parents who already have a Medical Alert Information Sheet filed with the school office should **contact Mrs. Revel** to review and update it for the 2017-2018 school year.

STUDENT SUPERVISION:

Teachers will be on hand to supervise students starting from 8:35 am until 3:15 pm each school day. **Students are NOT permitted to play around the Grotto and the surrounding bushes at any time and there is NO supervision on the primary playground in the morning.** If you will be late picking your child up after school, please notify the school office preferably before 2:55 p.m. at (604) 929-0345.

PARKING AND DROP OFF PROCEDURES:

Please ENTER the school grounds from Mount Seymour Parkway and EXIT only onto Brockton. There will be **NO stopping or drop off in front of the school.** Parents who are escorting their child to the school should park in the designated parking areas and accompany them to the back entrance of the school. Please ensure that you are driving slowly and being respectful of traffic supervisors at all times. Students are to remain outside on the school grounds until the 8:50 am bell. Please note that there is NO supervision on the primary playground in the morning.

LONG RANGE CALENDAR:

Attached is the school's TENTATIVE long range calendar for the **2017-2018 school year.** Please keep it handy for easy reference and make any updates throughout the year. You will be notified of any changes to the calendar in our weekly bulletin. Staff at St. Pius X, meet on various days throughout the school year to engage in professional development and activities which support student learning. Please provide your daycare provider with the list of all Early Dismissal and Professional Days.

STUDENT AGENDA BOOKS:

All students in Grades One to Seven will be utilizing agendas to promote time management, organizational and communication skills. The agendas will be used by students to record items such as: daily homework, assignments, reminders and upcoming events. The agenda is also used to facilitate regular communication between parent and teacher regarding important information, such as: work habits, accomplishments, behaviour,

and reasons for incomplete work, upcoming absences, or the need to meet for an interview. Please look over your child's agenda nightly as a means of tracking homework and keeping tabs on upcoming class activities.

Thank you to all parents who volunteer their time to help make St. Pius X the special school that it is! Your generosity of time, talent and service is greatly appreciated.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

We will begin our Cross Country program (Students in Grades 2-7) and our Volleyball program (Grades 5-7 girls) during the first week of school.
